PATHWAYS TO OPPORTUNITY



Dear Community Partners,

I'm excited to share some recent updates from our Disability Navigation Program that will make it easier than ever to connect individuals and families with the support they need. For those of you who were recently added, our Disability Navigation program assists families connect to resources and guide them through the application process for the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) Medicaid Waiver (also known as iBudget or Home and Community Based Services - HCBS). In Lee County (other counties coming soon), we also help navigate families through the Guardian Advocacy process.

We've just received a new shipment of Disability Navigation packets! If you'd like some for your office, please don't hesitate to reach out—I'd be happy to drop them off. We've also refreshed our outreach materials and now have updated flyers available for distribution.

To make referrals more convenient, we've introduced a Google Form that allows you to submit referrals directly to me and my team. The QR code for the form is printed on the flyer, making it easy to scan and complete. You're more than welcome to submit on behalf of someone you support—this helps us ensure quick and meaningful follow-up. While you can continue to email me directly, we have also created a designated email for disability navigation that will go to my entire team - disabilitynavigation@goodwillswfl.org.

In addition, we're currently developing a series of short videos designed to help families better understand the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) and the Medicaid Waiver (iBudget). We're also finalizing updates to make our materials available in multiple languages, helping us reach and support even more individuals in our community.

Q What is one example of growth you have noticed in your participants in the past year?

A men's club participant struggled to talk & needed prompts during our circle time 2 quarters ago. He required prompts to verbalize even a single word. Now, he shares stories about his weekend AND his verbal interactions through the day have doubled!

PTO is their Home away from Home!








