Thank you for inspiring us and for reminding us of the power of kindness and community. Here's to more uplifting sessions and the beautiful journey of empowerment together!





Major Milestone: Senate Bill 1758 Passes!

We're thrilled to announce that Senate Bill 1758, a groundbreaking piece of legislation aimed at enhancing care navigation services, has officially passed! Pathways to Opportunity had the incredible opportunity to have representatives present during this pivotal moment, advocating for the needs and rights of individuals with disabilities and their families. Senate Bill 1758 is set change the support system for those with disabilities by:

- Mandating the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) to offer care navigation services, ensuring a robust support network.
- Integrating care plans with Individual Education Plans (IEPs) for students with disabilities, fostering better coordination in public schools.
- Introducing an online application process for APD services, improving access and efficiency while maintaining traditional methods.
- Developing a comprehensive transition waiver for clients moving into adulthood, addressing a critical gap in support.
- Reducing the crisis response time from 45 days to 15, making a significant difference in timely assistance.
- Lowering the definition of an aging caregiver from 70 to 60, acknowledging the changing needs of our community.

This legislation represents a monumental step forward in creating a more inclusive, supportive environment for individuals with disabilities and their families. We're honored to have been a part of this process and are excited about the positive impacts this bill will have on our community.

A huge thank you to Senate President Kathleen Passidomo and everyone involved in making Senate Bill 1758 a reality. Together, we're building a brighter future!


