- Only see special needs adults up to age 20
- Treatments completed at surgery center exam, x-rays, cleanings, restorative and crowns.
- No extractions or endo
- Patients' class ASA 1 and 2 are desired no BMI over 35, no sleep apnea, no previous complications with anesthesia
- Accepts Medicaid PPO If your insurance is not considered "in-network" you could still be seen here
 but you would need to contact your insurance and ask for a pre-authorization to be seen at the surgery
 center.
- Timeline will receive an exam within a months' time, once exam is completed if authorized for treatment then surgery will be scheduled a couple weeks later. Plan for 4–6-hour appointment times.

- Must have Liberty Medicaid or ly but does not need "hospital coverage" via insurance. Out-of-pocket pay is an option.

- Sees patients at Tampa General Hospital. Does offer IV sedation in office.
- Considered out of network for Medicaid plans but you can call your insurance and ask to have special needs case manager assigned to you for your dental plan. Once one is assigned, the case manager can start an authorization process to be seen here.
- Initial exam required for Dr to determine behavior and health qualifications for IV.
- 3-month waitlist for IV sedation and 6-month waitlist for hospital after initial in office exam.

If none of these options are right for you or your loved one, call your insurance and ask them to find you a provider. It is part of their job to do so.
